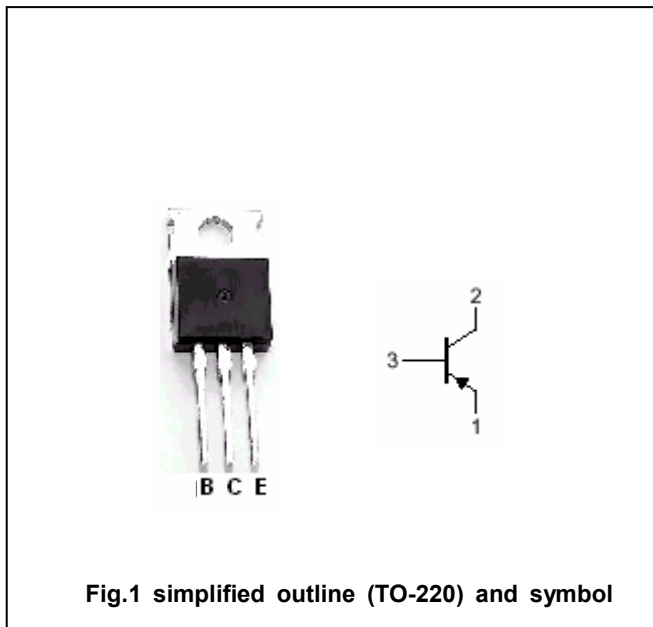

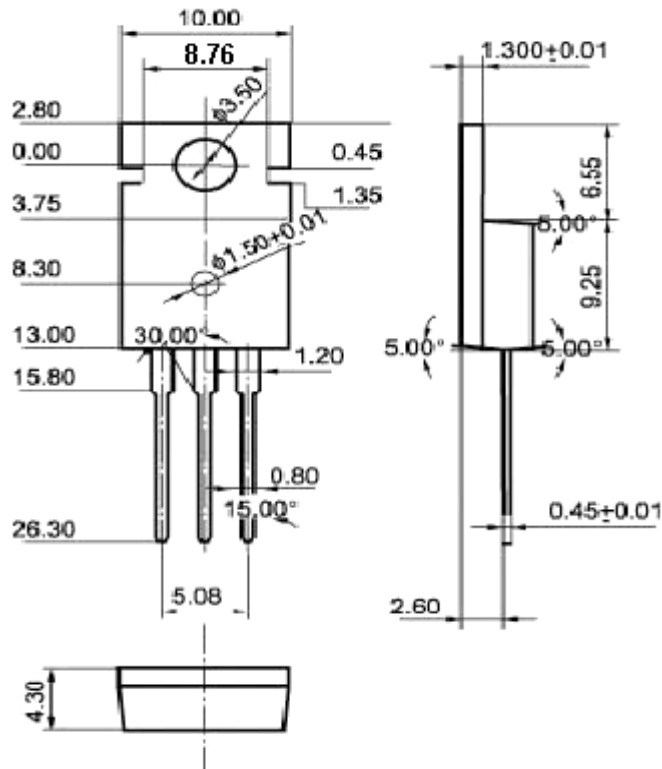


Fig.2 Outline dimensions (unindicated tolerance: ± 0.10 mm)

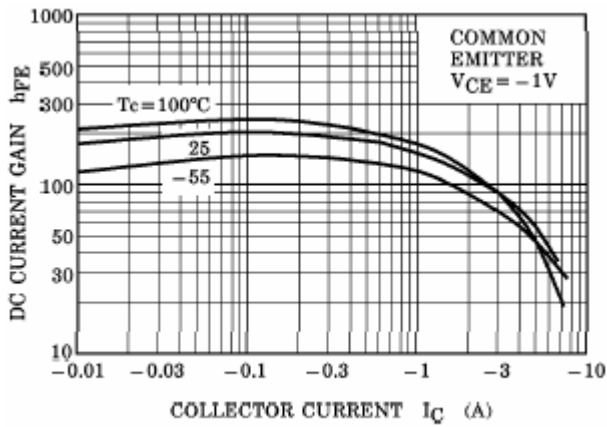


Fig.3 DC current Gain

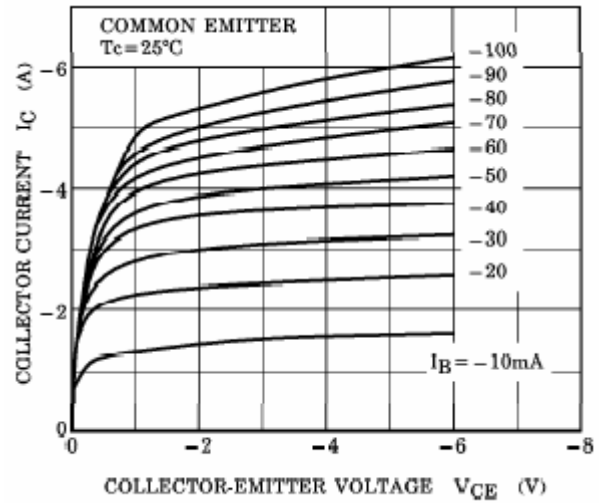


Fig.4 Static Characteristic

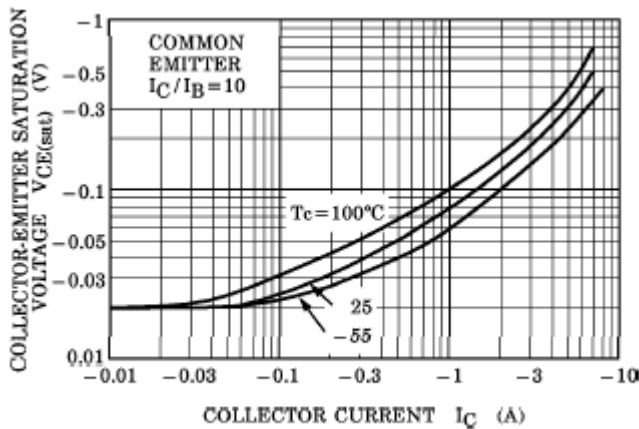


Fig.5 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

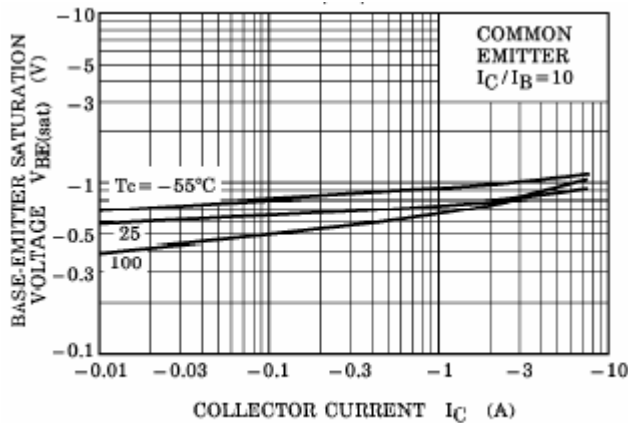


Fig.6 Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage

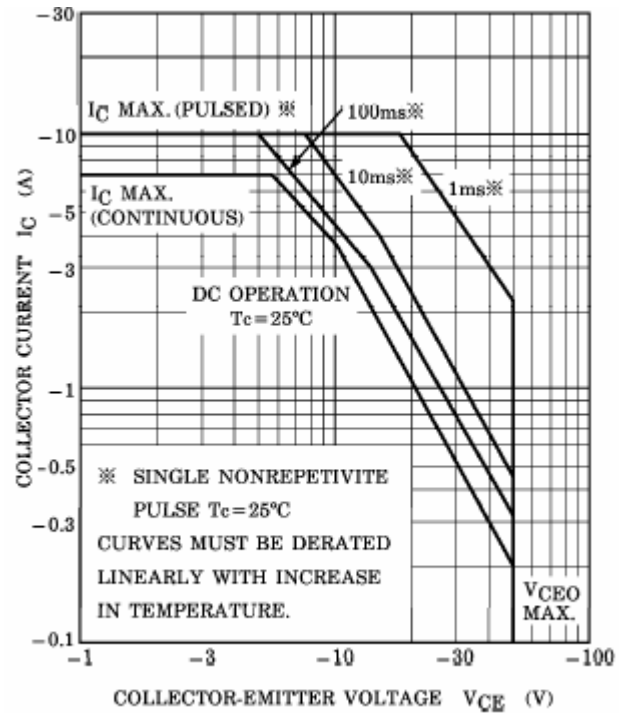


Fig.7 Safe Operating Area
